# **Statement of Faith**

### **Volunteer Needs**

- 700 Hours of Total Volunteer Need
- \$28.11 per hour is the estimated value of a volunteer hour in South Carolina

# **Volunteer Tracking**

- We will credit each volunteer \$30 per hour of service
  - Varsity level games are 1.5 hours
  - JV and below are 1 hour
- Concessions will be allocated based on the cost of the items being supplied



# **Organizational Expectations**

- \$330 worth of contributions PER PLAYER any combination of service hours (\$30 per hour, i.e. 11 hours) or concession contributions
- OPT-OUT: \$330 up-front payment
- \$165 deposit BY CHECK will be held
  - No deposit on file will not be allowed to play
  - If no hours logged by 1/1, check will be cashed and another deposit check of \$165 will be required
  - If hours logged by 1/1, then you will have until 2/5 to complete your hours – check will be cashed if hours requirements not satisfied

# Communication

- More communication = better. When in doubt, over-communicate
- Communicate early & often
- Dispute resolution
  - Approach the coach first
  - $\cdot$  If unresolved, Basketball AD can be involved
  - If larger issue after coach & AD, Board involvement



- Expenses ~\$22,000
- Estimated Player Count: ~70 players
  (\$300+ per player in expenses)
- Income is from Player Registration Fees, Concessions/Admissions, and Donations
